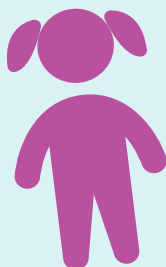
Come count with us!

If you're up for a challenge, start at 10 and count down to 1!

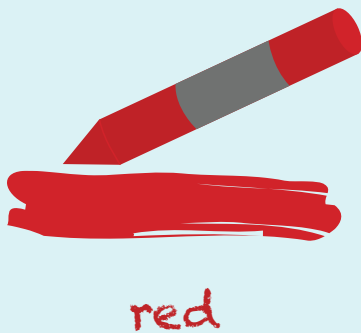
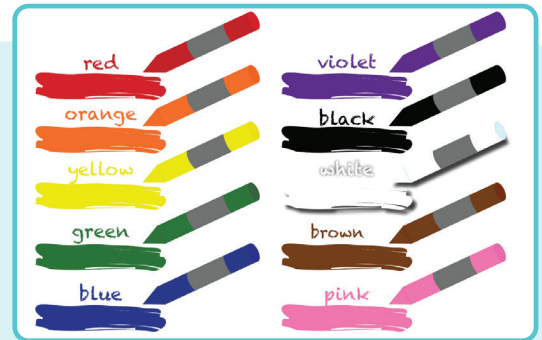


I KNOW MY COLORS

SKILL: Color Recognition

HOW TO PLAY:

1. Select the colors that you want your child to learn.
2. Look up the pictures of these colors.
3. Show your child the pictures, point at them and read out the name of the colors.
4. Ask your child to repeat after you as you say the name of the color while pointing at the picture.
5. Encourage your child to look around for something else that is the same color.



Parent: This is a red crayon. Can you say red?

Child: Red.

Parent: Can you say red again?

Child: Red.

Parent: Can you look for something red around you and shout red?



Wonderful! Please clap for each other!
Now you can try some other colors.

Trixia learned her shapes and colors really well. She likes to wear pink things.

Tell your child something they have done well today.



PARENTING TIPS

Make discipline positive. Tell your child what they can do, more than you tell them what they cannot.
